COURSE DESCRIPTION

1.1. Course objectives

The aim of the course is to introduce the students to the approach to disabled persons. Students will be able to show the knowledge, understanding and attitudes related to health promotion and helping the persons and their families in facing the developmental disorders; skills needed to collect the data, planning and managing health care and outcome evaluation; main theoretical knowledge and understanding techniques and specific interventions related to health problem solving; ability to function as a competent member of a multidisciplinary team.

1.2. Course enrolment requirements

Acquired knowledge and passed the following exams: neurology, pediatrics, physiatry, communicative skills and bioethics.

1.3. Expected course learning outcomes

The student is able to recognize specific problems and conditions related to disabled persons, to plan and carry out the care and to evaluate the outcome. He has the knowledge and understands the techniques and specific interventions aimed at solving health problems of disabled persons and adequate approach to their special needs.
